Thank you for your interest in the Inaugural running of the Mayor's 5K Run/Walk with this year's proceeds benefiting Autism Awareness. Autism Spectrum Disorder is present in approximately 1 out of every 88 births according to the Autism Society. Therefore, the City of Rushville recognizes the need to create awareness about autism and hopes to achieve those means through this event. Since the 1970's, April has been recognized as National Autism Awareness Month. We hope this time period gives us the opportunity to provide public education about autism and the autism issues faced within our community.

This event is a fast, scenic 5 Kilometer (3.1 mile) run/walk showcasing some of Rushville's most attractive landscapes. The event kicks off at Riverside Park Amphitheater, home to Rushville's *Live by the Levee* summer concert series, then travels north through Rushville's historic district on the way to North Veterans' Park and the Veterans' Memorial Bridge. Participants will enjoy the sights and sounds of spring as they wind their way through the park trails before heading back to Riverside Park Amphitheater where the race will conclude with the presentation of awards to Division winners and refreshments.

Proceeds collected through this event from entry fees and donations will benefit ARC of Rush County and the Alex Workman Memorial Fund. ARC of Rush County is a volunteer-based membership organization made up of individuals with intellectual, developmental and other disabilities, their families, friends, interested citizens, and professionals in the disability field. The Alex Workman Memorial Fund was established to provide support to children with autism. The annual distribution is available to families who have autistic children or a Rush County teacher who works with autistic children on a competitive grant process.

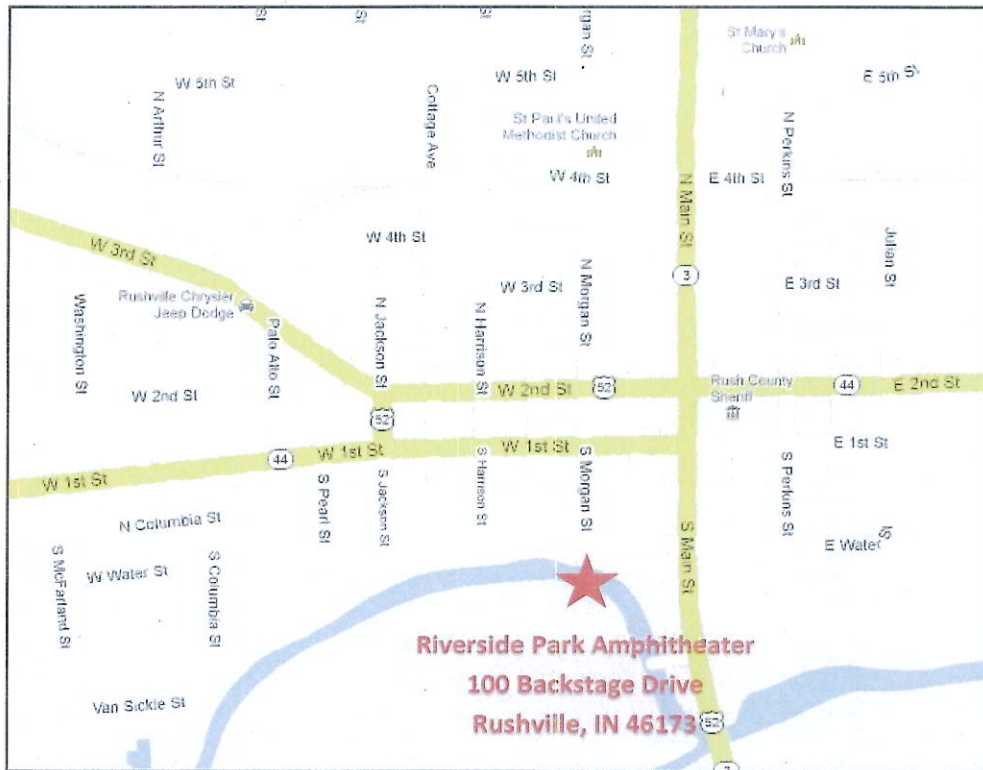

Directions to Riverside Park Amphitheater



From I-74 and State Road 44:

Travel eastbound from I-74 on State Road 44 to Rushville City Limits. State Road 44 becomes West 1st Street. Travel eastbound on West 1st Street to South Morgan Street. Turn south on South Morgan Street, and travel two blocks. The entrance to the park will be immediately in front of you. Parking is available at the top of the hill as well as at the bottom of the hill near the amphitheater.

From I-465 and US Highway 52:

Travel eastbound from I-465 on US Highway 52 (Brookville Road) to the Rushville City Limits. US Highway 52 becomes West 3rd Street. Travel eastbound on West 3rd Street to North Morgan Street. Turn south on North Morgan Street, and travel three blocks. The entrance to the park will be immediately in front of you. Parking is available at the top of the hill as well as at the bottom of the hill near the amphitheater.

From I-74 and State Road 3:

Travel northbound from I-74 on State Road 3 to the Rushville City Limits. State Road 3 becomes South Main Street. Travel northbound on South Main Street to West Water Street. Turn west on West Water Street, and travel one block. The entrance to the park will be to the south (left). The entrance to the park will be immediately in front of you. Parking is available at the top of the hill as well as at the bottom of the hill near the amphitheater.

From I-70 and State Road 3:

Travel southbound from I-70 on State Road 3 to the Rushville City Limits. State Road 3 becomes North Main Street. Travel southbound on North Main Street to West Water Street. Turn west on West Water Street, and travel one block. The entrance to the park will be to the south (left). The entrance to the park will be immediately in front of you. Parking is available at the top of the hill as well as at the bottom of the hill near the amphitheater.
